

Calvary Church in Pittsburgh Seeks New Curate or Associate Rector

Calvary Episcopal Church in Pittsburgh, PA seeks to call a new Curate or Associate Rector to begin in the late spring or summer of 2018. We will receive resumes and interview candidates until a successful call results.

Calvary Church, founded in 1855 in the East End of Pittsburgh, is a diverse and inclusive community that seeks to proclaim and embody the Good News of Jesus Christ.

We have long had a commitment to welcome all people in the name of Christ and serve our neighbors in our city and beyond. Our beautiful Gothic Revival building, designed by Ralph Adams Cram, was completed in 1907. We use the building to partner with more than forty outside groups who share space with us to help make the city a more just community for all.

As a congregation focused outwardly, we have experienced steady growth in the last several years. We have an excellent, traditional Anglican music program as an integral part of our high church worship and a strengthening program of Christian formation for all ages.

Our city of Pittsburgh is a leader in the new high-tech economy with health care and education forming the foundation of its redevelopment. It is consistently rated one of “America’s Most Livable Cities.” Calvary is located near the University of Pittsburgh, Carnegie Mellon University, Chatham University, hospitals, numerous restaurants, and tech hubs.

The Curate or Associate Rector will join the staff of this large and healthy parish sharing in preaching, sacramental life, teaching, pastoral care, and outreach. The particular focus for this ministry is to attract, welcome, and integrate newcomers and to minister with the young adult population. In the last four years, the number of those aged 20-40 in the parish has grown from a handful to more than 100 people.

The new clergyperson on staff may expect intentional mentoring from two full-time experienced priests and to become a part of a caring and committed team. She or he will follow a successful Associate Rector who was called, after three years at Calvary, to serve as a rector in his home state in the largest parish in the diocese.
