Gift cards for Giant Eagle & Target

these are SO helpful and are used weekly to buy groceries as needed, especially items like fresh produce, milk, cheese and yogurt that cannot be easily donated.

Staples gift cards for office supplies

Fruit and vegetables: single serve size (no applesauce needed at this time)

Cereal: individual boxes variety packs

Instant Oatmeal individual packs

100% Juice (individual boxes or pouches)

Snacks: graham cracker, saltine crackers, ritz crackers, goldfish, pretzels, cheese-itz, teddy grahams.

Chef Boyardee: single serve cups & cans

Microwavable Individual Side Dishes (rice, pasta, etc.)

Dreft laundry soap

Liquid hand soap: bulk refills or individual

Paper towels

Baby Formula: Similac Advance (blue container)

Diaper rash cream: small tubes that can go home with the child as needed

Kids plastic plates, bowls, & forks (forks can have the metal fork part)

Kids Travel size toothpaste
